

Towards the realization of <u>UN Women Moldova</u> <u>Strategic Note 2018 – 2022</u>, and following a competitive selection process, UN Women has signed 10 Project Cooperation Agreements (PCAs) with nongovernmental organizations from the Republic of Moldova. The NGOs will implement projects in one or more of UN Women's three impact areas: Women's political participation and decision-making; Women's economic empowerment; Ending violence against women.

OBJECTIVE

• Increase the participation of women from both banks of the Nistru river in the political life of the country, through modern training on leadership and participation in decision-making.

EXPECTED RESULTS AND ACTIVITIES

- 160 teachers will be trained on leadership and political participation;
- Establishing a new specialized Network of teachers from the left bank of Nistru, to promote the participation of women in political life;
- 400-600 young women have access at the local level to relevant information materials on women's leadership and political participation;
- At least 10-20 NGOs/educational institutions from both sides of the Nistru river, specialized in women's rights will create an NGOs Network (Open Coordination Committee);

Women, young women, ethnic minorities, teachers, rural women, ethnic minority women (including Romani)

May 2018 - May 2019
